35 Members Celebrate Contracts Inc.

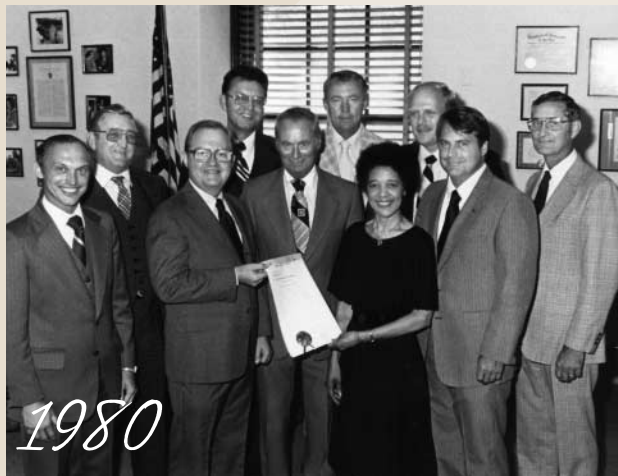
1989: Members approve 35-year supply contracts, paving the way for Boswell Unit 4 purchase and future projects.

1992: Roy Thilly takes the helm as general manager.



1996: South Fond du Lac Unit 4 becomes operational.

1998: WPPI plays a key role in drafting and securing passage of the Wisconsin Electric Reliability Act.



2002: Two wind turbines in Worthington, MN go online, adding 1.8 megawatts to WPPI's renewable energy portfolio.

2002: Members unanimously approve long-term power supply contract extensions, adding 13 years to contracts established in 1989.

2000: WPPI purchases a 5.7 percent interest in American Transmission Company, culminating a 15-year effort to own a piece of the transmission grid.
